HIGH STREET UNITING CHURCH NEWS 10 July 2020

Dear Friends,

We are back in a period of having to stay home to stay safe, and to help keep our whole community safe. It looks like I'll be back to having one child at home doing remote learning, and the other (in year 10) back on campus but with even more stringent care around social distancing.

As I mentioned in the update earlier this week, this means that some of the small gains we were making for small groups physically meeting (like "Open" and the walking group) are wound back again for now.

Just over a fortnight ago, the Church Council established a working group which now goes by the name of the Community Outreach Team. The Team has met twice already, with the following purpose:

In Christ's Love, to draw together the High Street Uniting Church community and the wider City of Frankston community through active and ongoing support. To initiate and oversee activities that are valuable, sustainable and safe with flexibility to accommodate changing restriction.

The Community Outreach Team is now working on three strands:

- 1. Promotion of the free hot lunches that are being provided at Community Support Frankston, five days a week (take away only).
- 2. Promotion of the **drop-off points for food donations**, which are distributed by Community Support Frankston. There are bins for the collection of packaged food and long-life food at the following locations:
 - Coles (inside Karingal Village Shopping Centre 110 Ashley Avenue, Frankston
 - Coles (inside Gateway Shopping Centre) 230 Cranbourne-Frankston Road, Langwarrin
 - Ritchies IGA 280Seaford Road, Seaford Cnr Seaford Rd & Frankston-Dandenong Highway
 - Coles (Carrum Downs Plaza) 335Ballarto Road, Seaford Cnr Ballarto & McCormicks Road
- 3. Developing our own initiative for providing hot soup for those in need, at a time when other services are less available. We had hoped to say more about that this week, but with a return to lockdown the Covid Safety Oversight Group will be reviewing the timing of what we can do so as not to increase risk among vulnerable people.

This week's gospel reading is of the Parable of the Sower and the Seeds. The Sower just kept sowing, and some initiatives worked and some didn't; some took time to develop, and some produced wonderful fruit. We'll continue to sow the seeds of prayer and thought, and continue to keep up care for one another in whatever ways we can. Please don't hesitate to reach out to the Elders, the members of the Contemporary Oversight Group, Pastoral Carers, me, or the church office, if you need support or even just a conversation. As we continue to look out for one another, may God's presence and steadfast love be with us and keep us.
